

# Supplies for 2011-2012

## Kindergarten

### **EACH ITEM MUST BE CLEARLY LABELED.**

Fiskars Scissors (please label with name)  
Paint shirt (adult's old tee shirt)  
Gym shoes (separate pair kept in locker)  
Kleenex – 1 box (large)  
Crackers – 2 boxes, regular size, such as Ritz or graham, not tiny ones  
Backpack – large  
Markers – 2 boxes (classic colors only, 8 or 10 count)

## Primary

Expo dry erase markers – 2 packages 4pk  
Zippered pencil pouches, not plastic, 8" X 10", (smaller sizes will not hold all supplies)  
Pencil sharpener with lid - 2  
Crayons 2 - **(boxes of 24 only in each)**  
Glue sticks – 8 large  
Markers – 8 pack of wide tip  
White glue – 1 bottle (4oz)  
Scissors (please label with name)  
Pencils – 24  
Pencil erasers – 6  
Colored pencils – 3 packs of 12  
Gym shoes (separate pair kept in locker) – Your child should be able to tie the shoes themselves  
Smock (old shirts are fine, kept in locker)  
Backpack or book bag **(no wheels, no luggage)**

Single-subject **spiral** notebooks – 1 (Grs. 1 & 2), 3 – Gr. 3, wide-ruled  
Erasers, large – 2  
Plastic folders for homework – 2 (not Trapper Keepers)  
Watercolor paints (labeled)  
Clorox disinfecting wipes containers – 3 (Not Baby Wipes)  
Kleenex – 2 large boxes  
**Grade 1** – 4-pack of household sponges, Ziplock bags – 1 box of sandwich size (50 ct.)  
**Grade 2** – Ziplock bags - 2 boxes of quart-sized (20 ct.)  
**Grade 3** – Ziplock bags – 1 box of gallon-sized; red pens - 2

These are the only supplies needed. Too many supplies are difficult for primary students to organize.  
\*Remember for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester to check with your child for restocking.

## Please help us set up your child's supplies

- Label scissors, colored pencils, paints, markers, and crayon boxes.
- Please put the following unwrapped items in the pouches:
  1. 3 sharpened pencils
  2. 1 glue stick
  3. Pencil sharpener
  4. Scissors
  5. 1 eraser

Remaining pencils, glue sticks, pencil sharpeners, and erasers should be unwrapped and placed in one large Ziploc bag with your child's name on it.

## Intermediate

### **Please label all items except spirals**

Clorox wipes – ~ 2 - 35 count or 1 large  
Zippered pencil bag – 1 only  
Pencils #2 (24)  
Colored pencils - 12  
Six glue sticks  
Ruler (standard and metric – **a must**)  
Crayons (Box of 24 only)  
Correcting pens (any color EXCEPT blue or black) - 4  
Scissors (fabric scissors)  
Markers, watercolor – wide and fine tip  
Dry erase markers – 2 packages of 4 (chisel tip)  
**Wide-lined** loose-leaf paper  
(**not** college ruled)  
Book bag or backpack – must fit in locker  
Gym bag – shorts, shoes, shirt  
Large box of Kleenex - 2  
Seven separate spirals – **wide-lined**  
Accordion file organizer - ~13x9 ½ in  
(**Plastic or fabric, no binders or individual folders – a must**)  
3”X5” lined, white index cards (~50, 4<sup>th</sup> only)  
Bible\*  
Hi-Liters – 2 (**yellow only**)  
Grades 5 & 6 - Protractor  
Grade 6 - Blue or black erasable pens – 3

\*Students in Grades 4-8 should have their own Bibles (Old and New Testament). A Bible is more than a text and should be a personal item. If you need to buy one, please buy the **New American Translation**. One source is Madison Church Supply, 820 S. Park.

## Junior High – Bring to school on 8/31

Clorox wipes – 3 containers  
Bible (may be from previous year)  
Binder, 1”, Heavy Duty  
Dictionary, Spanish/English, paperback  
3-ring binder (large) OR Expanda-file with 13 pockets  
Dividers for **binder – 3 sets**, don’t write on them  
Assignment notebook - 1<sup>st</sup> is free, additional ones may be purchased later  
Pencils (12) and pencil case  
Pencils, colored (12)  
Markers (4 dry erase & Crayola classic fine)  
Highlighters, broad (1 pkg., 4 colors)  
Pens ( 3 each erasable blue or black **and** red)  
Whiteout  
Scissors – good usable  
Loose-leaf paper  
Spiral notebooks – 6 - Don’t write on them.  
One should be a 3-subject one and one a graph paper notebook.  
Index cards (4X6)  
Glue stick - 2  
Gym bag (shorts, shirt, shoes, deodorant)  
Ruler – 12 inches, standard and metric  
Protractor  
Compass  
Kleenex – 3 **large** boxes  
Safety glasses –purchase from Mrs. Tourdot  
Scientific calculator  
Scotch tape - 2  
Locker shelves  
Waterless antibacterial hand sanitizer  
Erasers – 2 (pencil)  
Flashdrive – purchase from school. (We will make a bulk purchase in fall seeking largest memory for least cost.) If bringing one from home, **MUST** leave it at school throughout year so it is available when needed to carry work home & return.

**Junior High supplies MUST be in school on the first day because we label and organize them at this time.** These items need to be replaced during the school year when they are used up or lost. Please check periodically with your child.
