

Blessed Sacrament School Statement of Purpose

Blessed Sacrament School exists to create an educational atmosphere in which children can learn to relate to their classmates and to Jesus Christ according to the principles of the Gospels. Students at the school are viewed as unique gifts of God. Our role in their lives is to help them develop their individual potential by guiding them in emotional, spiritual and intellectual growth.

An important aspect of each child's personal development is to come to discover himself or herself as a member of a Christian community. Membership in this community teaches the child self-respect through the positive regard he or she receives from the community. The student learns respect for others by being shown how to act in a socially responsible way toward all people.

We believe that the child's experiences of Christian worship, work and play within the smaller community of the parish and school will serve as an introduction to an adult life style in the larger community which will continue to take its meaning from Christ's word in the Gospels. It is important that these experiences are reinforced through active participation in parish life.

Parents who enroll their child in Blessed Sacrament School should understand these goals and be willing, as much as possible, to establish a continuity of atmosphere and values between the home, school and parish.
